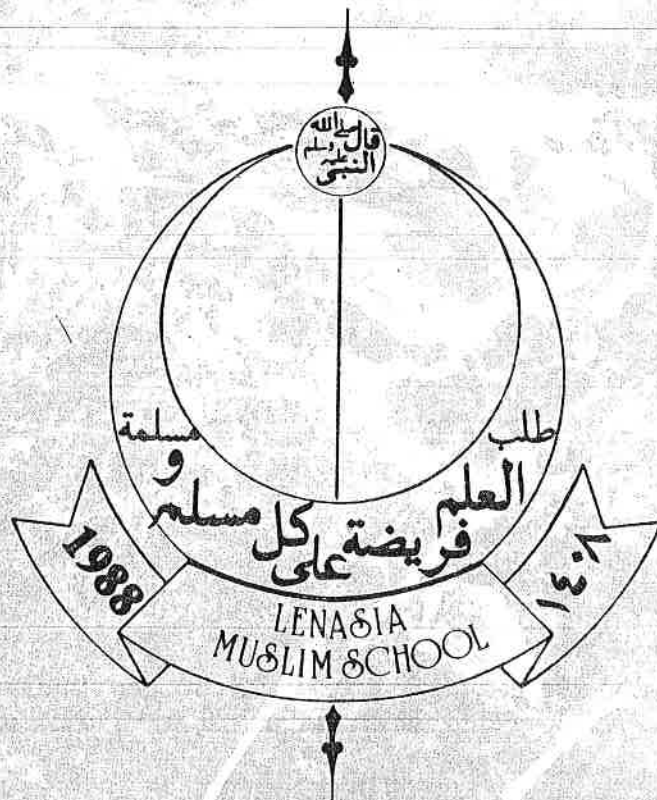

CONDITIONS OF ACCEPTANCE OF PLACE

1. We are aware that a term's notice must be given before a pupil leaves L.M.S or a full term's fees must be paid in lieu thereof. In addition to the tuition fees charged by L.M.S , we agree that we shall be liable to pay any increases in such fees or any special levy imposed by the LMS.
2. We accept joint and several liability to the L.M.S for the due and punctual payment of all fees , subscriptions , levies or other amounts which may become due and payable to the L.M.S or in respect of participation or attendance in any extra-curricular activity.
3. All pupils are subject to the regulations, rules and routine of the school as laid down by the head. Parents undertake to co-operate with the school authority in enforcing them.
4. Should a pupil be removed from the school by reason of breach of school rules, the parent shall remain liable for fees due for the full term during which the pupil was removed, and if such fees have been paid, the school shall not be obliged to refund any portion thereof.
5. The school accepts no responsibility for the insurance of pupils' possessions, parents are urged to ensure that their own policies cover these possessions.
6. A full term's notice of withdrawal shall be given in writing to the head, whether such notice is to be effective during the currency of a school year, or one full term's fees must be paid in lieu of such notice.
7. One full term's fees are payable in the event of withdrawal between the date of acceptance of a place offered and the beginning of term.
8. In the event of the school having to institute action to recover fees, the parents shall be liable to make payment of all costs incurred by the school, as between attorney and client.
9. In the event of action being instituted for outstanding fees, the parents will consent to the jurisdiction of the magistrates court.
10. Fees for each quarter should be payable at the beginning of each term.
11. If you have more than one child at the school you are also entitled to a discount - (contact school bursar).

ADMISSION POLICY

1. The Lenasia Muslim School is open to all learners, irrespective of race, ethnicity, disability, gender or religion.
2. The admission of pupils is subject to the availability of space in the respective grade to which the pupil seeks admission.
3. The ethos of the school is strongly "Islamic" in character and preference will be given to students who are able to cope with the compulsory religious subjects offered.
4. **Admission to the school will be determined by the following criteria :**
 - 4.1 Academic competence to cope with the respective Grade. Copies of previous reports to be attached (secular as well as islamiaat).
 - 4.2 Respect for the Islamic ethos of the school - even if the student does not belong to the "Islamic Faith".
 - 4.3 The pupil must have an unblemished record in respect of his/her behaviour at the previous school. A testimonial from an Alim or teacher is required.
 - 4.4 "The first come first served principle", will be given preference.
 - 4.5 Siblings will be given preference , provided they apply timeously and meet all other admission requirements.
5. Pupils of L.M.S who take leave to complete HIFZ on a full time basis will qualify for re-admission.
6. A pupil who seeks admission in **GRADE ONE** must turn 6 years before 30th June of the year in which admission is sought.
7. As a rule, the school does not admit students in Grades 10, 11 and 12. Representation to the Admission Committee in respect of exceptional cases will be considered.
8. The Admission Committee reserves the right to interview any applicant.
9. Applicants who are unsuccessful for the current year **must** complete a new application if they wish to apply for the following year.
10. The Admissions Committee reserves the right to accept applicants in any Grade, notwithstanding the above criteria. The decision of the Admissions Committee will be regarded as final.
